


Figure 1: ATHENA's website front page

 event.

 Work Packages: A short description of the scientific methodology that will be followed within the ATHNEA project is given here.

- Deliverables: A complete list of the deliverables as these have been approved and
 finalized by the EC. The type of the deliverable is also indicated as well as the
 expected date of their delivered. Public (PU) deliverables will be uploaded in this link
 so as to maximize the dissemination impact of the project.
- Training: Training is considered as the key element of the ATHENA project. In this
 link the major training event will be placed so as to maximize the dissemination
 impact of the project.
- **Dissemination:** This link will include all the dissemination actions taken by the partners during the whole lifetime of the project. These actions have been categorized as follow: Publications; Conferences; Press release; Videos and Leaflets.
- Partners Area: This link is the intranet of the project. In this area only registered users (i.e. partners of the project) will have access. The partner's area includes mainly three different types of actions: Forum; Files and Webmail.
