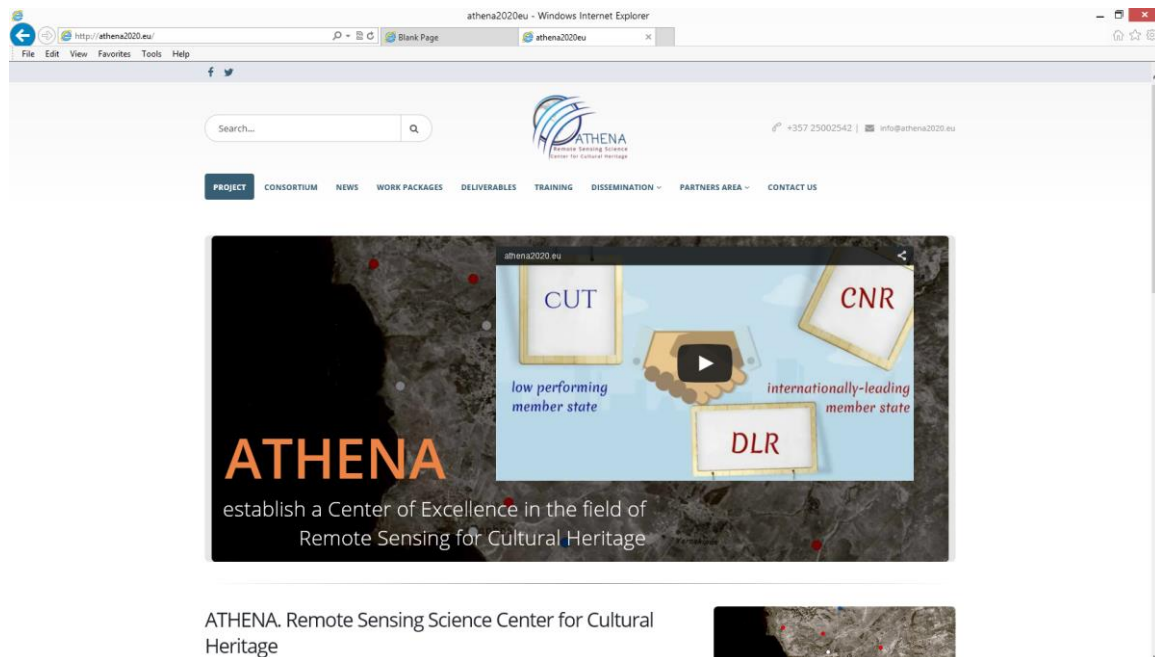


Figure 1: ATHENA's website front page

## 2. Website Design

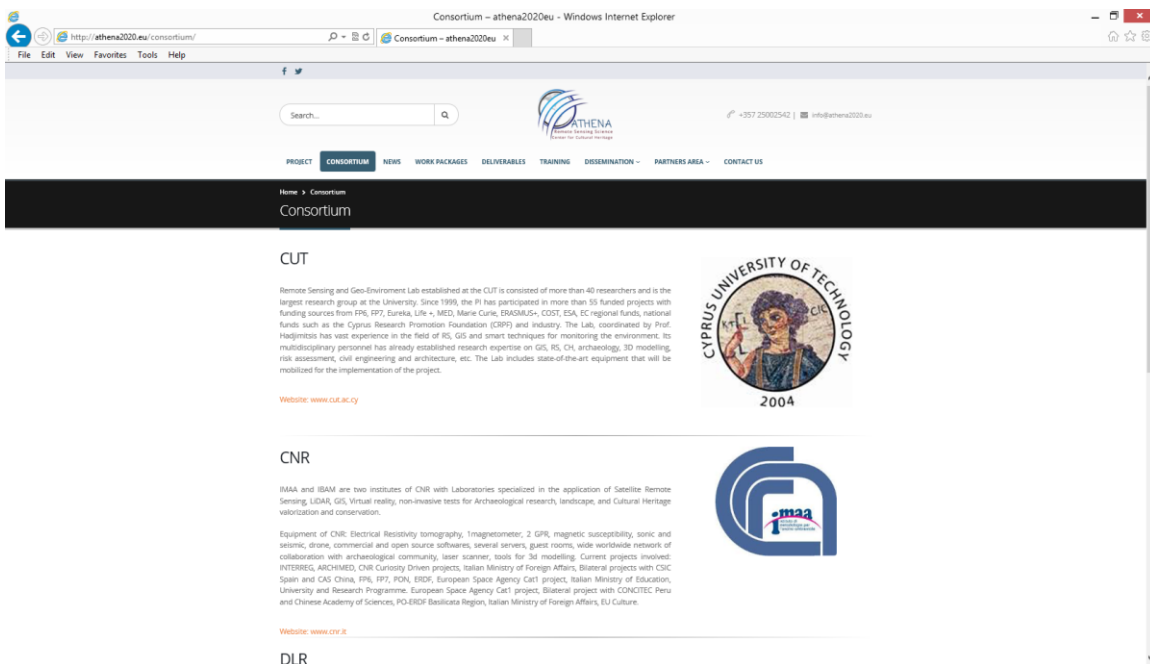
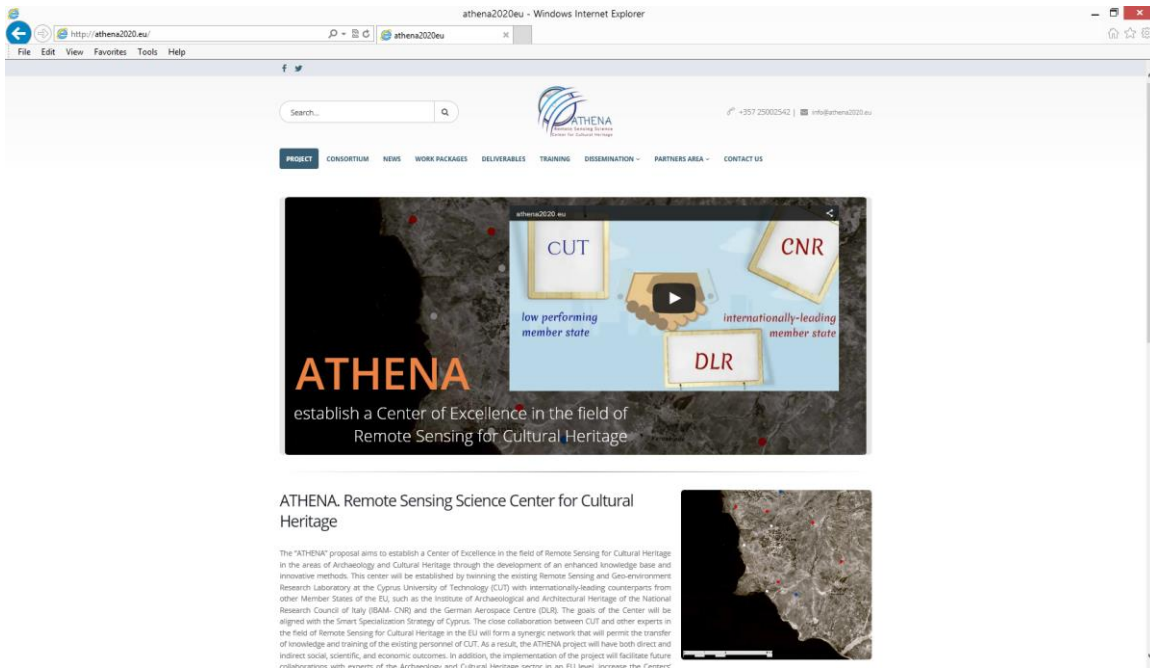
The website is designed so as to include all the necessary information for the ATHENA project. Nine (9) main thematic categories have been identified as indicated below:


