Background

Young people with stroke (YPwS)

- Early disability
- Reduced productivity
- Increased disability claim
- Significant out-of-pocket healthcare costs associated with their disability



Gaps on needs and preferences of YPwS

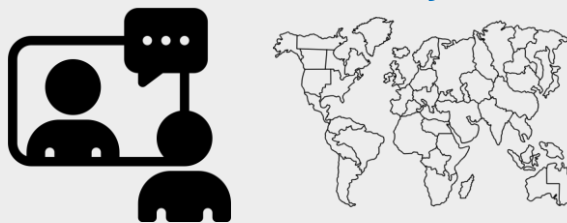
- Worldwide survey: young Caucasians from high-income countries
- Little information from different ethnicities and countries of varying socioeconomic levels and varying cultural backgrounds

Objectives

- 1) To raise awareness about the occurrence of stroke in young people;
- 2) To identify the unmet needs of YPwS across countries with varied income levels and varied cultural backgrounds;
- 3) To create repository and develop age-specific resources to meet the needs of YPwS

Phase 2: Scoping review

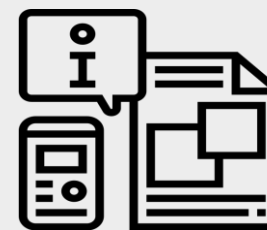

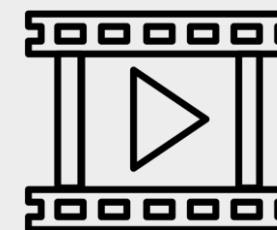

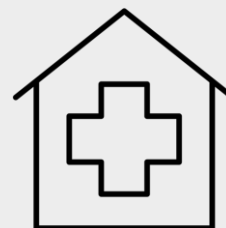
