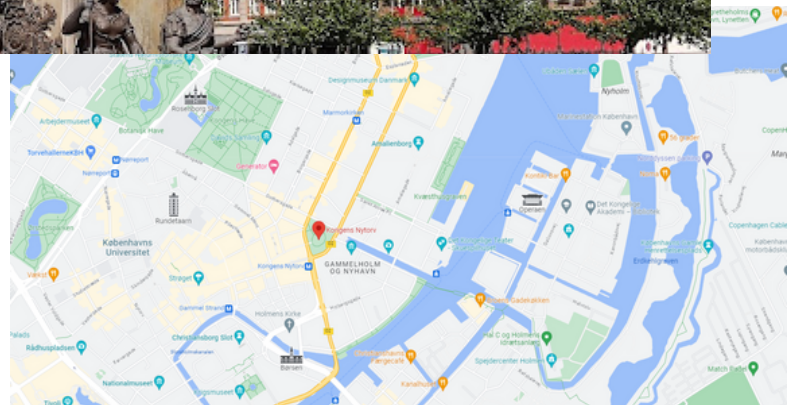
Identifying The Politics of Normative Spaces as Sites of Resistance in New Media
